

Extra Traffic to Impact Gilman

On Monday, Nov. 8, and Thursday, Nov. 18, contractors working on Maine Medical Center's Malone Family Tower will be orchestrating large concrete pours.

These pours will increase truck traffic up Gilman Street, past the hospital loading dock area and onto the access road. Unlike previous concrete pours, Gilman Street will stay open, but will experience extra truck traffic. Flaggers will be deployed to help with traffic flow.

The work will start at 6 a.m. each day, and run until 5 p.m. Site work involving concrete finishing will continue each night until 10 p.m. – a quiet operation that proceeds as the concrete sets.

This work is weather dependent; rain dates are Nov. 11 and Nov. 22, respectively.
