City of Portland Historic Preservation Board – Wednesday, April 18

Beginning at 5 pm (start of the meeting), the Portland Historic Preservation Board will host a workshop to conduct an advisory design review of Maine Medical Center’s proposed parking garage construction at 222 St. John Street. The project site is located in close proximity to the landmark Maine Central Railroad Office Building and as such the site plan ordinance’s “100-foot rule” applies. Under this provision, the Historic Preservation Board conducts an advisory review of the project and comments are forwarded to the Planning Board for its consideration, along with a written analysis of the proposed development’s immediate context. Public comments will be taken at this meeting.
