This week, Maine Medical Center (MMC) began the first phase of construction of its \$512 million expansion project at 22 Bramhall Street. This project will enhance our quality of care, improve our capacity, modernize our facilities and help us pursue our vision of working together to ensure our communities are the healthiest in America.

We wanted to take a moment to thank you for your continued collaboration, communication and feedback as construction begins. The Congress Street detour is in place and traffic is being re-routed smoothly; we appreciate your ongoing feedback as we work to improve the lives of our patients, visitors, and staff. We continue to monitor traffic flow and are making adjustments including additional signs to help mitigate impacts.

We expect to file our second site plan with the City of Portland within the next several weeks; this project phase includes the construction of a staff garage on St. John Street.
