## Roadwork Impacts on Gilman Street Neighborhood

---

Construction work that will impact neighborhood roads begins on Monday, Sept. 16.

This work is being done in preparation for the deconstruction of the Gilman Garage and construction of the new Congress Street medical tower. All of these dates are as scheduled, but are weather-dependent.

On **Monday, Sept. 16**, work begins at the intersection of Gilman and Congress streets **LIMITING ACCESS TO GILMAN STREET**:

- Vehicles travelling **inbound** on Congress Street (uphill) will be able to turn right onto Gilman Street and access the neighborhood.
- Vehicles travelling **outbound** on Congress Street (downhill) will **not** be able to turn left on Gilman Street, and will have to access the neighborhood via A Street.
- Vehicles **exiting** the neighborhood will have to leave the area via A Street.
- This work is expected to last until Sept. 28.

On **Monday, Sept. 30**, Gilman Street at the intersection of Congress Street will be **CLOSED**.

- **All vehicle traffic** in and out of the neighborhood will be via A Street.
- This work is expected to last until Oct. 11.

On **Monday, Oct. 21**, roadwork will continue on Gilman Street, above the garage entrance.

- Vehicles will be able to access the neighborhood via Gilman or A streets.
- Vehicles will only be able to **exit** the neighborhood via A Street.
- This work is expected to last until Nov. 1.

Flaggers and signs will be deployed to assist drivers as needed.
