

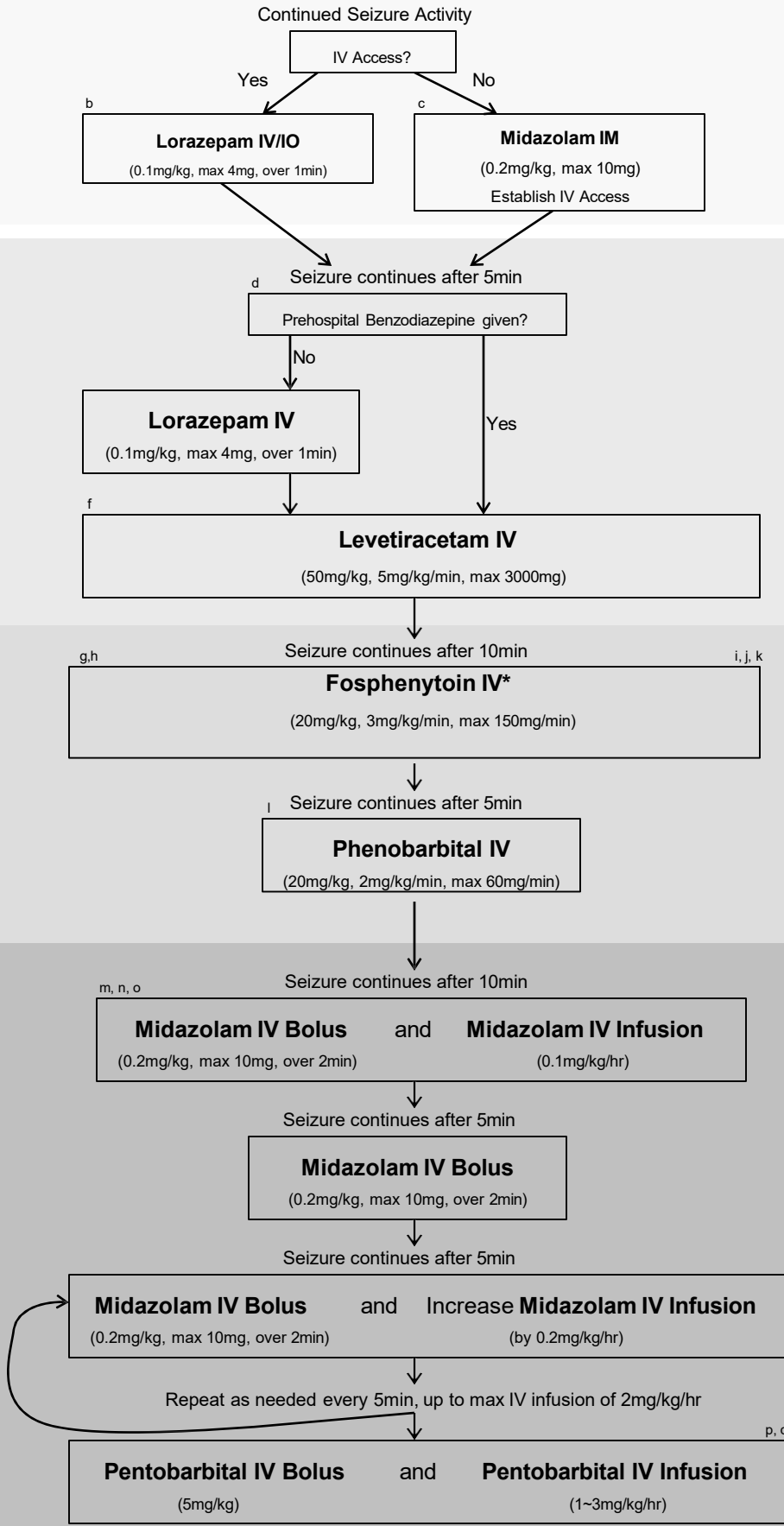
# Pediatric Status Epilepticus Protocol <sup>a</sup>

**Monitor:**

- Airway
- Breathing
- Circulation

**Labs:**

- Fingerstick glucose
- STAT sodium

**Monitor:**

- Airway
- Breathing
- Circulation

**Labs:**

- CBC & CMP
- If clinically indicated:
- Blood culture
- Head CT
- LP
- Serum AED levels
- Urine & serum tox

**Consult:**

- Neurology & PICU

**Monitor:**

- Airway
- Breathing
- Circulation

**Procedures:**

- Ensure adequate access (consider central venous line)
- Consider intubation prior to Phenobarbital
