<input type="checkbox"/>	Contact Dr. Ricci's office to speak with a clinician and arrange follow-up (879 – 6160)
<input type="checkbox"/>	Perform focused exam and skin surface assessment of entire body
<input type="checkbox"/>	Perform medical photography of any visible injuries (see medical photography)
<input type="checkbox"/>	Collect forensic evidence if appropriate (see lab and forensic evaluation)
<input type="checkbox"/>	Consider GC/C testing if appropriate (see lab and forensic section)
<input type="checkbox"/>	Offer urine pregnancy test if indicated
<input type="checkbox"/>	Offer pregnancy and STD prophylaxis in pubertal female
