## Admission Requirements

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### Follow the required steps below to be considered for admission:

- Complete **Application for Admission**. Download, print and return the School of Surgical Technology application from [mmc.org/surgtech](http://mmc.org/surgtech). Includes:
  - » Official sealed high school or equivalent transcript. These need to be mailed directly to the School of Surgical Technology.
  - » Submit two work references and three personal references.
  - » Provide non-refundable application fee of \$50. Make checks payable to: MMC School of Surgical Technology or call 207-741-5589 Monday-Thursday 8 a.m.-3 p.m.
  - » Print and sign your applicant authorization forms for us to obtain references from the names you provide.
  - » Mail all completed information to:

Southern Maine Community College, 2 Fort Road, South Portland, ME 04106
- Take **Psychological Services Bureau (PSB) Health Occupations Entrance Exam** and score in the 50th percentile or higher prior to start of school. (Offered 6x/year)
- Complete **interview with faculty**. After reference forms and transcripts are received, applicants interview with a faculty member.

Applications are accepted on an ongoing basis and we admit two classes of 14-16 students per year — one class in March and one class in September. Admissions close when a complete class of qualified applicants is achieved. Applications from qualified individuals received after closing may be considered on a space available basis or for the next class offered.
